Venue

Holiday Club Åre

Åre is located in Jämtland, about 630 km northwest of Stockholm. The conference venue is centrally located in the village.

Travel

We recommend taking the train to Åre.

Train

Åre's train station is immediately adjacent to the meeting venue, Holiday Club. Both day trains and night trains pass through here from most parts of Sweden. You can also travel between Åre and Trondheim a couple of times a day. Find trips through SJ (www.sj.se), Snälltåget (<https://snalltaget.se/>) and Norrtåg (<https://www.norrtag.se>).

Airline services

The nearest airport is the Åre/Östersund airport which is situated about an hour transfer (90 km) from Holiday Club. Airport coach service is adapted to the scheduled air traffic arrivals and departures. Normally, airport buses run for all flights. Taxi reservations can be made at flygtaxi (<http://www.flygtaxi.se>) and also through the local taxi companies in Åre which have preferred rates to and from the airport. SAS (<https://www.sas.se>) have daily flights to and from Åre and Braflyg (<https://www.flygbra.se>) operates Thursday to Sunday. Trondheim's Airport, Vaernes in Norway is also a reasonable distance from Åre (approximately 2.5 hours by train).

Free time during the conference

The program allows for free time until 3 pm (15.00) on Tuesday and after lunch Wednesday. Åre is a traditional mountain village and Scandinavia's largest ski resort and has been the host of the Alpine world championships both in 2007 and 2019. Åre is offering virtually every skiing style and a wide range of other activities.
